A cultural program is planned for Saturday, April 6th 2019 to celebrate Ugādi/ Tamil New Year/ Vishu. The cultural program will take place between **1:00 pm and 8:00 pm** at the SV Temple Large Auditorium. Please note:

- *Any entry submitted without the required and meaningful information, or after the deadline is not guaranteed to be part of the program*
- *Entries that reflect the themes of Ugadi/Tamil New Year/Vishu are strongly encouraged and preferred*
- *You will receive an email by **March 24th 2019** confirming your participation*

Eligibility Criteria:

- No individual event is permitted, including the invocation song
- Minimum of four participants per act
- Only one act per individual is allowed so that all other interested individuals will have a chance to participate in the cultural program
- Maximum of two items per choreographer/coordinator
- Maximum time allowed is five minutes for a dance/ song, and seven minutes for a group skit
- Only group singing is allowed
- Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis
- Maximum number of entries accepted will be based on time constraints; entries will be considered in the order they are received
- To keep each act unique, only one entry is allowed for an act per song/music combination. If anyone submits an entry which duplicates the song/ music of a prior entry received, the participant should be prepared to re-submit with an alternative back-up song.
- All music for the performances should be sent as a MP3 file by emailing to ugadi.svt@gmail.com before **Sunday, March 17th 2019**
